

Additional Information on Community Nights

Interested in setting up a community night for your non profit organization, school or group? Here is some information for getting your “Spirit Night” setup:

- Community Nights are held between 5pm and 9pm on Monday and Wednesday evenings.
- An organization has the opportunity to hold up to four community night per calendar year and dates are assigned on a first come first serve basis. Community night must have at least one month in between scheduled dates.
- The Galway Hooker Irish Restaurant and Pub reserved the right to evaluate the success and promotion of the community nights each calendar year. Spots will be given based on turnout.
- For children-based organizations, 100% of sales from every Kids Meal purchased by the organization will be directly donated back to your group (Kids Meals are \$4.50 each); Kids Meals must be accompanied by an adult entrée to result in a donation.
- All other organizations will receive 10% back from sales brought in by your organization. Simply tell your supporters to mention to their server that they are with the organization.
- All funds will be mailed within one week of the event.
